# 2. Length of Membership

#### 3. Gate and Door Access Codes

# General Facility/Property Rules:

- 12. Children and youth under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult- that also hold a membership
- 13. Leave your pets at home
- 14. Park your vehicles in designated parking areas
- 15. Please turn on the pump (in the furnace room) before using the washrooms & turn off the pump when you leave.
